Board of Health
Meeting Minutes from 5/21/14

BOH members present: Becky Allen (chair), Karen Brooks, John Doherty, and Jenna Day.

Meeting called to order at 6:40 pm.

The minutes from 5-7-14 were approved with corrections. Passed unanimously.

The Substance and Tobacco Prevention Partnership of Hampshire & Franklin Counties committee met and are not interested in increasing the age for tobacco purchases from 18 to 21 years of age.

The Board of Health received one phone call regarding food permit applications and one called asking for a phone number. Caller's received a call back with directions for the food permit and how to apply online. The other caller was given the phone number that we had on file.

Charlie Cornish sent an e-mail stating that he would not be at this meeting and would be out of town all next week.

The Board of Health signed the Septic Regulations, the Private Well Regulations, and the Temporary Occupancy Regulations.

The Board of Health signed a bill schedule for the posting of the Public Hearing notices that were in The Recorder.

The Board of Health received the report of Fatal Injuries at work for Massachusetts in 2012. There were not any work related fatalities in Franklin County in 2012.

Becky Allen worked with Matthew Lively to get him an online permit for a Septic Installer's Permit. The permit was issued.

The Board of Health discussed the inspections for camper trailers for the upcoming season. Charlie Cornish will be the lead on these for the upcoming year. We discussed what will be on the inspection form. Becky printed one out for Karen to see as it was voted on while she was on vacation.

The tick forms for testing are available in the downstairs hall and in the library. They will also be mailed with the Temporary Occupancy Regulations to all registered property owners.

Becky asked to purchase a desk and more envelopes. The Board of Health voted unanimously for these purchases.

Jenna Day announced that she will be resigning the Board of Health the end of June 2014.
