Meeting called to order at 5:40 PM.

Minutes from 5/6/15 reviewed and accepted as amended.

Board agrees to review BOH job descriptions and assign specific tasks to each member.

Oversight Board Meeting report discussion focus on Tick Test. Board entertained motion to pre-buy tests at a 10 % increase above last year's total. BOH will pay \$10 of the cost per test. Motion passed.

MEPOA beach reports reviewed, accepted and filed. Tank reports filed as 15" on L and 18" on R.

#8 Lakeview discussed regarding large fire. Also damage to #6 Lakeview due to fire. Board will contact owners of damaged property to discuss owners' intentions towards removing debris.

Board will actively contact MEPOA Board to set up review of policy.

Board moves to continue Mohawk Estates property inspection program. Betsy and John assigned to schedule and perform first round.

Board grants clerk permission to sign for Temporary Food Vendor permits

276 South Rd. : Failed Title V inspection. Perc Test did pass.

Board reviewed pumping reports.

Board reviewed nurse's report.

Board will recommend to Heath BOS to hold a late summer (early August) Clean Sweep and Swap Day.

Board will hold meeting to discuss Conservation Oriented Housing. Also, BOH will contact Planning Board to further discuss prospects for Heath on said topic.

280 8A North: Board formally requests FRCOG to further engage occupants in an attempt to gain compliance.

Board to submit article to Heath Herald regarding HRA loans and programs available.

#5 Ledges Rd. : Board will propose this property to BOS for request for Phase 1 of Brownfields analysis. Also discussed coming up with a list of abandoned houses that need revitalizing (not tear-downs).

Board reviewed MAHB invoice and will pay \$50 annual fee.

Board reviewed and signed annual contract with CPHS for their services.

#4 Shawnee & # 15 Eastbrook : Board to follow up on information regarding possible violations.

Board members reminded and encouraged to complete online NIMS course.

Board discussed proposal for Heath School wood boiler grant / loan. Board unable to make recommendation due to insufficient information.
