Meeting Minutes August 5, 2015

Heath BOH Members present: Karen Brooks, Chairman, Mike Freeman, Charlie Cornish, FRCOG Health Agent Glen Ayers, Citizen: Rol Hesselbart.

Meeting called to order at 5:40 pm.

The July 1, 2015 minutes were unanimously accepted as amended.

Camper Trailer Inspection- BOH discussed the possibility of changing the BOH policy of systematic inspections to responding to complaints and obvious infractions on all Heath properties. Further discussion is needed at next BOH meeting.

Clean Sweep/Swap Day- Set for August 8. New this year is a Salvation Army Box that will be permanently placed at the transfer station.

Farmers Market- At present time, participants are required to use a registered/inspected kitchen to produce non-potentially hazardous foods. Further discussion is needed to define BOH policies for all sales of potentially hazardous foods. Need to discuss multi use facilities in town with a joint use agreement.

Home Burial BOH Policy- Rol Hesselbart presented a joint effort policy that has been worked out over time with the BOH and FRCOG. BOH voted unanimously to accept the Guidelines for Establishing a Home Burial Plot in the Town of Heath as amended.

Nurses Report- Report was reviewed and accepted. Dr. Miller has agreed to be the cover doctor at no charge to the Town of Heath.

Water Test- BOH reviewed the Mohawk Beach Reports from the past couple of months submitted by the Housatonic Basin Analytical Data Company.

Permits - On line food permitting has worked well. Two have been sent in and paid for so far.

Pumping Reports- Two reports reviewed and passed.

Perc Test- Two homes had perc tests since last meeting and both passed. Another one is scheduled in the next couple of weeks.

Planning Board Meeting- Further discussion needed on unattached live-in dwellings.
