Mondays through Fridays Transportation is available for shopping, medical appointments, and to the Shelburne meal site on **Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays**.

Wednesdays – Transportation is available in mornings for shopping trips into Shelburne.

Fridays – Transportation is provided one Friday per month for a shopping trip to Wal-Mart and nearby stores in Hadley.

No medical rides are booked before 9:00 a.m. or after 2:00 p.m.

Please call 24 hours in advance prior to needing transportation. Transportation cannot be arranged over the weekend.

\$1.00 each way for all trips within town you reside in
\$1.50 each way for all trips to an adjacent town within our service area
\$2.00 each way for all trips beyond an adjacent town within our service area
