Board of Health  
Minutes from 8-26-2010

Meeting called to order at 6:02 pm.

Bob made a motion to accept the minutes as corrected. John seconded. Becky, John and Bob approved.

Temporary Food vendors at the fair were good inspections. There did seem to be a common mistake among the vendors. The sanitizing solutions containing chlorine were too strong at most vendors. Some were too weak and a few were correct. Becky did go with Glen to inspect 15 out of 18 food vendors.

Temporary Occupancy Permits were mailed out to residents as they came in. 32 more permits were issued.

The Board discussed how to regulate the temporary food vendors. John made a motion to only issue food permits to public function. Karen seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

We decided that all private functions do not need to come to the Board for a permit. Private functions are any that are not advertised. Advertising will consist of Newspaper, radio, television, and here in Heath advertising will also include posting an event on the public bulletin boards

John made a motion to deal with outside showers on a case by case bases. Bob seconded. Karen, Bob and John agree. Becky was busy on the telephone.

The Board discussed residential kitchens and the fact that we must have the required paperwork. Becky made a motion that we inform them and give them deadlines so they will get in the paperwork. John seconds. Passed unanimously.

12 Deer Run Path---- Is it a camper/trailer? Yes it is therefore it must be permitted.

Septic plans for 27 Underwood Hill Road-----The board will table these till September 2, 2010.

The Board of Health will conduct a special meeting on September 2, 2010 at 6 pm.

The Board received a letter from Donald Scagel. In it he states that the trailer located at 30 Papoose Lake Drive is being stored. It is against the Heath bylaws for it be there unless it is on a lot with a permanent structure. A permanent structure must have a conforming septic system and an approved well. At 7 Papoose Lake Drive he received a letter from the BOH years ago clearly stating that they had taken his word for the fact that it was a mobile home. Becky went out just to recheck the site. It is in fact a TERRY camper/trailer. Becky will send a letter to Mr. Scagel stating that the trailers must be permitted.----the one is not a mobile home and the other one must be permitted as well and not stored.

John will compose a letter to town council regarding the legality for exterior inspections. We will look at it at the next meeting.

There was a cat bite on Rowe Road. The cat was quarantined in the home.

Bob will get a sign for Whitmore Spring. The sign will state that the water cannot be used for drinking.

Karen made a motion to purchase an external drive to store the pictures from all the inspections. John seconded. Passed unanimously.

John made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Karen seconds. Passed unanimously.
