Minutes from September 24, 2010

Emergency meeting called to resolve issues at 34 Royer Road.

Members present: Becky Allen, Bob Bourke, Karen Brooks, Betty Nichols (arrived at 10:40 AM), John Doherty (arrived at 11:03 AM)

Meeting called to order at 10:06 am

Karen received a call last night to state that the tank was pumped and the tank left was left open. They also stated that there was no water.

The BOH contacted Glen Ayers. He stated that the board should check to make sure there is no water.

The board is unclear if the water was shut off or if the well has dried up. It has been a dry year and it is possible that the water dried up.

The BOH must go out and document all these facts.

Bob called Matt Lynde, the owner, to communicate these facts and make sure that he is aware of the them. Matt said that he received an e-mail at approximately 5 pm. He states that he has been there in person to investigate.

Matt Lynde states that the tenants have been an issue with him. The septic tank hauler did run water into the tank in order to get the tank flushed out.

Matt is worried that the pump might be shot. The tenants left it running for hours and it might not be any good.

Matt says he will look at the water situation this afternoon. Matt also stated that he will get the septic tank covered.

Bob gave him his home number so that he can call when he gets home from work so that the BOH can meet him at the property and make sure that this is resolved.

There is a cistern on the premises. It is a spring-fed well.

The owner will have to provide the tenants with water until this issue is resolved.

Meeting adjourned at 11:24 am.
