Ronnie Woodard would like a Kennel License. He has 4 dogs at his home currently and would like a Kennel License. He needs a certified list of abutters and a special permit application. He lives on Colerain Stage Road, below Chippewa. Kathy and Tom have 4 dogs. In the past, in the center of Heath, Woodard averaged 14 dogs, at times as many as 21 dogs. In the past Thelma would issue a kennel license which cost about 50 for 10 or more dogs. In about 2010, dogs needed to be licensed individually.

We will look into other kennel licenses in the town of heath. We will look into other people who register 4 dogs.

Seth Ginsberg would like to put in a solar facility. Seth works on solar and wind with eos ventures, jiminy peak. Focusing on 1 meg arrays that are community owned. Community shared solar garden. We suggested he come and talk to the REAC board and we sent him the solar overlay map.

Finalized the zoning bylaws version 3.1 and Cal will have Hilma print two copies for the FRCOG.

After review the bylaw states that "a kennel license is required whenever more than 4 dogs three months of age or older are kept on the same property". Cal will send an update to Kenny Woodard to that effect.
