

## STICKERS/ PERMITS

(Both Required)

Fees / Rules for FY18:

**Stickers: \$1.50 each for one per 33 gallon bag or, two 15-gallon kitchen bags tied together is acceptable. Affix sticker to secured neck of bag(s). Refuse only. No contractor bags allowed. Max. capacity 33 gallons or 25 pounds per sticker.**

**Permits: Annual Fee July 1<sup>st</sup> – June 30<sup>th</sup> \$15 each** Valid vehicle registration is required to purchase permit. Proof of residency may be required (i.e. phone bill, utility bill, lease, etc.)

The Town is not responsible for lost, stolen or misplaced transfer station permits. **Please affix permit properly to passenger side rear window.**

### **REPLACEMENT PERMIT: \$10 \***

\* A piece of old sticker must be shown with COMPLETE number still intact to receive replacement sticker. Only available for permits purchased in current fiscal year.

If you are selling your vehicle or switching to different vehicle, you must salvage and return permit to the Town and replacement permit will be issued for \$10.

**Acceptable Items Covered  
Under Transfer Station  
Permit**

Household trash (with pre-paid sticker per bag), recyclable paper, glass, plastic and cans; propane tanks (\$5 fee); batteries (all kinds); small metal items, push lawn mowers, small snow blowers, or any other small item (must be free of organic material e.g. pillow ticking must be removed from mattress bedsprings); other appliances or large items for metal bin may be disposed of provided you obtain pre-paid receipt from the Heath Post Office **prior** to disposal (\$10 fee). **NO** refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners or anything that has traces of refrigerant even if legally tagged.

## HEATH RECYLES!

It is important that everyone do their part to recycle – it's good for the environment, it's good for you, and it's good for the Town. And, it's easy!

**Recycling is required and mandatory** in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts (310CMR19.017). All glass, metal, plastic, paper, including cardboard, are prohibited and must be recycled.

**METAL:** aluminum, tin/steel cans and lids and aluminum foil (labels ok); EMPTY aerosol cans from food products

**PAPER:** All paper and cardboard must be clean & dry and please break down **before** you arrive at the transfer station; junk mail (plastic windows okay); Boxboard (cereal, shoe, cracker boxes, etc. – remove plastic liners); newspapers/inserts, magazines, catalogs, paper bags, white and colored office paper, computer paper, corrugated cardboard (flatten, remove tape and string); paperbacks and phone books; pizza boxes (only portions not contaminated by food or grease); gift wrap (no metallic or glitter); gift bags, cards. Boxes that contained refrigerated or frozen items including beer boxes or holders are **NOT** recyclable as they contain plastic fibers to keep them from breaking down.

**NO** soda or beer holders/cartons

**NO** waxed paper or waxed cardboard

**NO** egg cartons

## PLASTIC / GLASS:

Glass bottles/jars; plastic containers less than 2 gallons -- labels, lids, corks, neck rings, etc. are ok but only if attached to container; milk and juice cartons (tent top), drink boxes (remove straws & caps, flatten); plastic bottles, jars, clamshells and tubs (remove pumps). Labels and detergent spouts may be left on; health and beauty aid products are okay

**NO** light bulbs, window or auto glass, dishes, glasses, Pyrex, ceramics, broken glass, or black plastic

**NO** paint or other metal objects

**NO** plastic bags, containers over 2 gallons, motor oil jugs, chemical or Styrofoam containers or flower pots.

**SALVATION ARMY BOX:** Please discard any stained or ripped fabric, clothing, and shoes as well as books, tapes, CDs, DVDs, and small toys in closed bags in the Salvation Army Box. This saves space in the compactor.
